Prerequisite – Delegates must meet the minimum age of 18 years and be fluent in English. Delegates must be physically able to carry out the practical elements of the course and must be confident with heights.

Course:

This course is aimed at Adventure Parks or Ropes Courses that need specific training on activities such as climbing walls, zip-lines and nets etc and don't necessarily need full instructor training covered in our Traditional High Ropes or Adventure Park Instructor Courses. RIDGDGEAR will design a bespoke training course that will be specific to the site needing training. The duration of the course will depend on the amount of activities included.

Course Objectives:

To provide the relevant skills and knowledge to a delegate so they can perform their daily operations as an instructor for their specific Adventure Park.

Course Content:

This bespoke training course may include some of the course content detailed below. Additional content may be added depending on the site training requirements.

Training Methods:

This training course combines theory and practical training methods to ensure delegates receive the information required in preparation for their assessment. Printed course material, practical demonstrations and hands on training will be conducted throughout the course. All training is designed and delivered to meet BS 8454:2006 code of practice for the delivery of training and education for work at height and rescue, and meets the training requirements set out in EN 15567.

Certification:

On successful completion of the course, delegates will receive a RGAT approved training certificate to show they have the skills to work as an Instructor for a specific site. Instructors must keep up their CPD by attending regular on-site training to refresh their skillset.

PPE Requirements:

Delegates must provide their own comfortable clothing, protective footwear and prepare for all weather conditions. Delegates may be required to provide their own PPE but this will be communicated by RIDGDGEAR in the planning stage of training.
