

TRAINING COURSE

Description: MEWP Harness Use & Inspection
Duration: 0.5 Days

Prerequisite:

- No previous experience or qualification required.
- Delegates must meet the minimum age of 18 years and be fluent in English.

Course:

This training course provides the core knowledge required for the correct selection, inspection and use of PPE for working in MEWPs. Delegates will be able to identify the intended use of common items of fall protection equipment and will be able to conduct statutory PPE inspections on harnesses and lanyards.

Course Content:

- Legislation / guidance
- Mechanics of a fall
- Physics involved during a fall
- Fall factors
- Selection of fall protection equipment (includes common hazards associated with different equipment types)
- Correct selection of working methods (avoidance, work restraint, work positioning and fall arrest)
- Harness and lanyard inspection
- Declaration of conformity, traceability, inspection and record keeping of PPE
- Strengths and characteristics of equipment including limitations of use and quarantine procedures.
- Anchor points and devices
- Donning a harness
- Storage, care and maintenance
- Rescue requirements and options

Training Methods:

This training course combines theory and practical training methods to ensure delegates receive the information required in preparation for their assessment. Printed course material, practical demonstrations and hands on training will be conducted throughout the course.

All training is designed and delivered to meet BS 8454:2006 code of practice for the delivery of training and education for work at height and rescue.

Certification:

On successful completion of the course, delegates will receive a 5 year IPAF recognised certificate on behalf of RIDGEGEAR.
