Description: Scaffold Rescue

Prerequisite - Delegates must have completed RGT1 or equivalent recognised course. Must also be physically able to carry out the practical elements of the course.

Course:

This half day training course provides the core knowledge required to select, inspect, set up and use safety harnesses and emergency descent equipment for either rescue or evacuation on a scaffold structure.

Course Objectives:

This course will give the delegates the practical skills on how to use the RGR14 Ridge Rescue Kit to rescue a casualty to the ground. Raising or lowering techniques can be deployed using the rescue device to allow movement to a safe location. On completion of the course, delegates should be able to identify suitable anchor points, safe descent paths whilst taking care of a casualty. Delegates must have successfully completed a recognised fall protection equipment, awareness & inspection course.

Who will benefit?

All personnel in your organisation involved in planning, carrying out, supervising and managing rescues from height in the work place.

Course Content:

- Requirements for rescue (Work at Height Regulations 2005)
- Legislation / mechanics of a fall
- Pre-use inspection & function checks (includes practical exercise)
- Site considerations (anchor points, drop zones, general observations)
- Donning a harness (practical exercise)
- Storage, care and maintenance of equipment
- RGR14 Ridge Rescue Kit
- Raising and lowering techniques
- Identification of safe descent paths
- Suspension trauma / casualty care

Training Methods:

Lectures, printed course material, practical demonstrations and hands on exercises in inspecting, checking, setting up and using evacuation and rescue equipment using our specially built rescue training rig.

Certification:

Successful delegates will receive a 3 year RidgeGear certificate.

PPE Requirements:

Delegates must provide their own comfortable clothing and protective footwear and prepare for all weather conditions. Delegates may be required to provide their own PPE.

Course duration / Number of delegates:

The course is designed for up to 6 delegates at any one time and is held over half a day, typically 09:00-12:00 and 13:00-16:00.
